I look forward with happy anticipation to what adventure life gives me next!



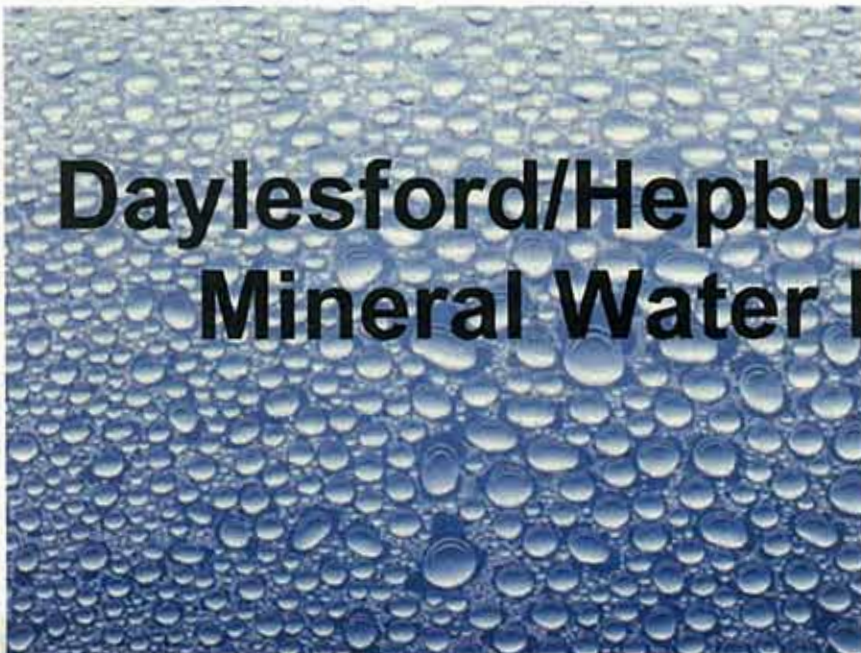
